• COVID ASSISTANCE FOR REHOBATH, NEW MEXICO:

From Ron P, project coordinator:

Good morning Friends--here's the story. Most of you have read about the spread of the virus on the Navajo reservation. There seems to be no relief--the infection and death rate is up there with New York and New Jersey per capita.

We need your help--there is a desperate shortage of cleaning supplies, Clorox, wet-wipes, hand sanitizers and spray bottles. With a few of my Christian brothers, we are hoping to collect a big trailer full of supplies for transport to some of our churches, who in turn share them with their parishioners and neighbor, most of whom are poor and live in very remote places on the Rez. We will also need money for fuel for the trip, and to buy more product.

Would you be willing to buy or gather any of the supplies listed above and bring them to my garage, (behind Project Hope, off BC Lane) If you were to write a check, write to Rehoboth Christian School, Food Distribution. We hope the truck and trailer to leave in a week, June 17.

Rehoboth has become a major distribution center on Eastern Navajo, and they have contacts and a process to share with our churches. Would you believe that 40% of folks on the Rez do not have running water, and 30% do not have electricity-this is in America, folks! They live in close quarters, pile into one vehicle/pick-up, travel on dirt roads from these remote areas to get to the highway. Mckinley and SanJuan counties are amongst the very poorest in our country.

This may seems like a strange request, but having lived there for 23 years, I know so many of these dear folks and their churches--we would sure appreciate your help. And prayers!
