• SERVE WORK PROJECTS:

The following is an overview of the projects the teams hope to be working on during SERVE week:

- ** **Bay House** A couple in their early 60's, the husband recently had heart surgery and needs oxygen and the wife is in stage 2 of MS, need yard work done, the house and small shed painted, and some general cleanup.
- ** Blue House A deaf mother and son live in a small house needing extensive repairs including window replacement, cleaning gutters, fixing garage door, cleaning, power washing, scraping, and some painting, and yard work (tree removal).
- ** **Yellow House** The homeowner has MS and uses a walker to move around, she needs some minor yard work, gutter cleaning, and house painting done.
- ** **Nooksack Woods** This single woman is overwhelmed with caregiving, job, and maintaining a yard, and she needs help doing yard work, tree/bush removal, replacing a picket fence, and cleaning gutters.
- ** **The Barn** This non-profit dedicated to local youth and church ministries needs some small carpentry tasks, cleaning, painting, landscaping, and exterior projects done.
- ** **Project Hope** This ministry dedicated to assisting the disadvantaged and hungry in the area need help sorting donated food, filling orders, assisting with food distribution.
- ** Habitat for Humanity H4H is building a house near the foothills of Mt. Baker, and need volunteer crews to do whatever they ask, or in case of rain, help in their store.
- ** **Cedar Springs** This Christian retreat center needs help on their walking trail system, specifically to uncovering the footings of an existing railroad trestle.
