* **Scripture:** *Acts 10:1-23a (ESV)* pg. 1151 ¹ *At Caesarea there was a man named Cornelius, a centurion* of what was known as the Italian Cohort, ² a devout man who feared God with all his household, gave alms generously to the people, and prayed continually to God. ³ About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a vision an angel of God come in and say to him, "Cornelius." ⁴ And he stared at him in terror and said, "What is it, Lord?"
